CUCA is an organization of industrial utility customers whose member companies maintain numerous industrial manufacturing facilities and employ thousands of workers throughout the State of North Carolina, including the territory in which Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("Duke"), Duke Energy Progress ("DEP"), Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion, North Carolina Power ("DNCP"); Piedmont Natural Gas Company ("Piedmont"), Public Service Company of North Carolina ("PSNC"); and Frontier Natural Gas Company ("Frontier") have been authorized by the Commission to sell electricity and natural gas at retail.

4. CUCA's member companies use electricity and natural gas in the operation of their manufacturing plants. The availability of an adequate supply of electricity and natural gas at a reasonable price is critical to the economic viability of CUCA's member companies. As a result, CUCA has a vital interest in the matters at issue in the above-captioned proceeding and should be permitted to intervene and participate.

5. CUCA agrees to accept electronic service of all filings in the Docket.

WHEREFORE, CUCA respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order allowing CUCA to intervene and fully participate in the above-captioned proceeding, including the right to discovery, and to otherwise exercise all statutory rights provided to Intervenors under North Carolina law.
