BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 31, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearings, Filing of Testimony, Establishing Procedural Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice in this docket. Among other things, the Order scheduled a remote hearing for the purpose of receiving public witness testimony regarding the application for the conditional CPCN to construct a 275-MW solar facility in Richmond County, North Carolina. The remote public witness hearing was scheduled for Wednesday, November 3, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., and the August 31, 2021, Order noted that the public witness hearing may be canceled if no significant protests were filed with the Commission after the publication of Public Notice.

On October 18, 2021, the Applicant filed an Affidavit of Publication of Public Notice certifying that the Public Notice had been published in accordance with the Commission's order. The Public Notice was published in the Richmond County Daily Journal, a daily newspaper of general circulation in Richmond County, on September 4, September 11, September 18, and September 25, 2021.

On October 28, 2021, the Public Staff filed a Motion to Cancel Public Hearing. The Public Staff states that, as of the date of its motion, it has received no complaints regarding the proposed facility and no complaints have been filed in the docket.

Considering the foregoing and the record in this proceeding, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to cancel the remote public witness hearing scheduled in this docket for Wednesday, November 3, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. Therefore, the scheduled


remote public witness hearing is hereby canceled, and the Commission will proceed as it deems appropriate in its consideration of the application.
