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## PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSIONER BROWN-BLAND: Good afternoon.

We'll come back on the record and we will begin with the hearing in E-22, Sub 556. I am Commissioner

ToNola D. Brown-Bland, the presiding Commissioner for this hearing, and with me this afternoon are Chairman Edward S. Finley, Jr.; and Commissioners Jerry C.

Dockham, James G. Patterson, Lyons Gray, Daniel G.

Clodfelter and Charlotte A. Mitchell.

I now call for hearing Docket Number E-22, Sub 556, In the Matter of Application by Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina for Approval of Demand-Side Management and Energy Efficiency Cost Recovery Rider Pursuant to G.S. § 62-133.9 and Commission Rule R8-69. That Statute and Rule establishes the procedure for cost recovery of Demand-Side Management and Energy Efficiency expenditures and provides for an annual DSM/EE Rider for the electric public utility.

Rule R8-69(f) provides that the public utility shall publish notice of the annual hearing at least 30 days prior to the hearing.

On August 21, 2018, Dominion Energy North Carolina, hereafter Dominion, filed its annual

Application for approval of DSM/EE Cost Recovery Rider.

On September 7, 2018, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling the Hearing, Establishing Discovery Guidelines and Requiring Public Notice; and the hearing in this docket was set for today, November 5, 2018, at this time.

Participation in this docket by the Public Staff - North Carolina Utilities Commission is recognized pursuant to G.S. § 62-15.

On October 2nd, in response to a motion filed by the Public Staff, the Commission issued an Order changing, or rescheduling the expert portion of the hearing to be held Thursday, November 8th at 9:30 a.m., following the hearing in Subs 558 and 557.

On October 15, Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates I filed a Petition to Intervene, which was granted by Commission Order dated October 24, 2018.

And on -- also, on October 24, 2018,

Dominion filed the required Affidavits of Publication of Notice.
