BY THE CHAIRMAN: On August 6, 2010, North Carolina Eastern Municipal Power Agency, North Carolina Municipal Power Agency Number 1, Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc., Duke Energy Carolinas LLC, and North Carolina Electric Membership Corporation filed a Joint Motion requesting an extension of time to file comments in response to the August 3, 2010 Order Requesting Comments on Modifications to Rules R8-64 Through R8-69 and Interim Operating Procedures for NC-RETS issued in the above-captioned dockets.

The Chairman finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time. However, as noted in the August 3, 2010 Order, the Commission has already made preliminary decisions regarding numerous issues raised by the parties in their initial and reply comments and their suggested revisions. The Commission's intent in this further round of comments is to seek comment on the specific amendments proposed to implement these decisions, on issues addressed by the Commission but not raised originally by the parties, and on potential conflicts with the NC-RETS Interim Operating Procedures.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the deadline for all parties to file comments in response to the Commission's August 3, 2010 Order shall be extended to and including September 20, 2010.
