BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On July 2, 2018, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, scheduled this matter for a public witness and expert witness hearing on Tuesday, September 18, 2018.

On September 7, 2018, Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and the Public Staff (collectively, Movants) filed a joint motion requesting that their witnesses be excused from attending the expert witness hearing on September 18, 2018. The Movants state that counsel for Movants have consulted with counsel for all parties in this docket and all parties have agreed to waive cross-examination of Movants' witnesses and offer no objection to the introduction of the Movants' testimony and exhibits into the record.


