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We recently received notification from our neighborhood water supplier, Springdale Water and Sewer LLC that there is to be a public hearing on March 11 2020 regarding a proposed rate increase. We live in Springdale Estates in the Summer and are residents of Florida during the Winter so are unable to attend the hearing. Your email was provided to us as an alternative means to express our feelings regarding the proposed rate increase.

As I understand it the monthly water rates are being increased by 182% per month and for those residents on Water and Sewer the increase is 148%. I appreciate the need to increase the usage rates because our infrastructure is seemingly always in need of repair necessitating inconvenient outages on a fairly regular basis.

I do not have a problem with the proposed rate increases except in the case of the request to increase our monthly base charge (zero usage) for water from \$6.59 per month to \$30.00 per month and for Sewer from 10.81 per month to \$36.00 per month. When we are not in the house we winterize, shut off our water and are charged a fee for shut off. It does not seem appropriate that we would be charged such a significant amount more per month when there is zero usage and our water is shut off for 5 or 6 months.

I would appreciate your consideration of these circumstances in the review of the application put forth by Springdale Water and Sewer to the NC Utilities Commission

Mr. Franklin:

The purpose of my email is to support, 100%, the recent letter sent to Springdale NC residents by Cliff Stovall. I am sure you are in receipt of his opinion regarding the proposed rate increase for water and sewer service at Springdale Country Club. Mr. Stovall, a long time resident of Springdale, is retired military, a Vietnam veteran, a church Treasurer and Deacon, and has served on the Boards of at least two prominent businesses in Haywood County. Further, Mr. Stovall is a trusted, detail-oriented accountant. Anything Cliff tells you, you can take to the bank.

Whatever decision the Utilities Commission ultimately decides regarding a rate increase at Springdale, I respectfully request that the owners of the water system be required to meet certain ongoing performance guidelines. We have lived at Springdale for almost 15 years. During that time, at a minimum, the water system has been shut down for "repairs" a conservative average of twice per month. The shut downs can last anywhere from 2 hours to 8 hours. A very real issue for residents occurs when the water is turned back own. We are instructed to let the water run until it is clear which is beneficial to protect filters in refrigerators, etc. However, homeowners who have water filters systems for water coming into the house, are forced to change out the filters in their dual-filter systems because the water is so dirty when it is turned on after repair. At \$20 + per filter, this can become pretty expensive (\$500+ per year). I believe homeowners in Springdale feel that some price adjustment for the water provider is in order. At the same time, based on the Provider water system's history, I would like to see a \$20 credit - for each home - on the Provider's monthly invoice for each time, in a given month, the water is turned off. *Residents are led to believe that the water system has been completely repaired. If this is the case, the Provider has very little risk in agreeing to a "credit per breakdown/shut off" performance criteria.*

Unfortunately, I am out of town until late April and will not be able to attend the March 11 hearing. However, your consideration of my comments, herein, is appreciated.
