BY THE CHAIR: On February 12, 2024, the Public Staff filed a Second Motion for Extension of Time to allow parties until March 1, 2024, within which to file initial comments and until March 15, 2024, within which to file reply comments pursuant to the Commission's October 4, 2023 Order Requiring Filing of Rates and Allowing Comments regarding rates charged by passenger ferries regulated by the Commission. The Public Staff notes that its work in this docket has been consumed with outreach to encourage the currently authorized passenger ferries to file current tariffs of rates and charges and timetables with the Commission and requests time to review the filings to ensure that the Public Staff's and other intervenor comments may reflect accurate information.

After careful consideration, the Chair finds good cause to grant the Public Staff's Second Motion for Extension of Time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That parties may file initial comments on the Commission's ratemaking treatment of passenger ferry rates and charges on or before Friday, March 1, 2024; and
 - 2. That parties may file reply comments on or before Friday, March 15, 2024.
