BY THE CHAIR: On December 30, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Granting Extension of Time, which in part extended the date for parties to file reply comments to on or before February 26, 2021.

On February 22, 2021, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association (NCSEA), the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (SACE), and the North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance (NCCEBA, together with NCSEA and SACE, Movants) filed a motion requesting that the filing date for reply comments be extended to March 5, 2021. In support of their motion Movants stated additional time would be required to analyze the Supplemental Filing made by Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP) and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC, together with DEP, Duke) on February 12, 2021. Movants further stated no party to the docket objected to the proposed extension.

Based on the record and the motion of the Movants, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for parties to file reply comments to on or before March 5, 2021.
