BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On January 21, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Approving Stipulation, Granting Rate Increase, and Requiring Customer Notice in the above-captioned proceeding. Ordering Paragraph 5 of the Order required Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (PSNC or the Company) to file clean versions of the new and revised tariff and service regulations to comply with the Order within five days from the date of the Order.

On January 26, 2022, PSNC filed its Revised and Clean New and Revised Tariff and Service Regulations stating the effective date for all tariff and service regulation revisions was February 1, 2022. However, PSNC proposed an effective date of April 1, 2022, for the Transportation Pooling Agreement to allow for sufficient time to complete execution of new agreements with poolers, implement necessary changes to the electronic bulletin board that will enable imbalance trading, and conduct training for poolers on these changes. On March 29, 2022, PSNC filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file and implement its Service Regulations Appendix A — Transportation Pooling Agreement until June 1, 2022. In support of its motion, PSNC states that the Company requests additional time to complete execution of new agreements with poolers and to implement changes needed to the electronic bulletin board that were identified during the testing phase of the enhancements that will enable imbalance trading. The Public Staff has indicated that it does not oppose the motion.

Based on PSNC's motion and the record, the Presiding Commissioner hereby grants the motion to extend the time to file and implement PSNC's Transportation Pooling Agreement to June 1, 2022.
