BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 13, 2019, Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC) filed an application in the above-captioned docket for approval of a cost recovery rider for its costs of demand-side management and energy efficiency programs. The application included the testimony and exhibits of six DENC witnesses.

On October 22, 2019, the Public Staff filed the testimony of David M. Williamson and Michael C. Maness.

On November 4, 2019, DENC and the Public Staff (Movants) filed a joint motion requesting that the Commission excuse their witnesses from attending the expert witness hearing to be held on November 12, 2019. Movants state that they have reached agreement on the rates proposed by DENC in this proceeding, that they have agreed to waive cross-examination of each other's witnesses, and that the only other party to this docket, Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates I, has also agreed to waive cross-examination of all witnesses.


