23, 2014, Hardison Farm Solar, LLC (Ap-25, 2014, Hardison Farm Solar, LLC (Applicant), filed an application, as amended on September 1, 2015, seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 4.99-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 19919 U.S. Highway 64 in Williamston, Martin County, North Carolina.
