BY THE CHAIRMAN: Pursuant to Commission Rule R8-60(h), North Carolina Electric Membership Corporation (NCEMC) is required to file an annual resource plan on behalf of its member cooperatives by September 1, 2011. Pursuant to Commission Rule R8-67(b) and (c), GreenCo Solutions, Inc. (GreenCo), is required to file an annual REPS compliance plan and REPS compliance report, respectively, on behalf of the electric cooperatives that GreenCo represents by September 1, 2011.

On August 24, 2011, NCEMC and GreenCo (Movants), filed a joint motion for an extension of time until September 19, 2011, for the filing of the above-referenced reports. GreenCo noted that its annual reports will include data for Mecklenburg Cooperative and Broad River Cooperative. These cooperatives have requested that GreenCo serve as their aggregator for such purposes.

Movants state that NCEMC's Board of Directors will meet on September 14, 2011, and consider approval of NCEMC's 2011 load forecast and that the Board's action on the load forecast will be an important factor in shaping the content of the Movants' reports to the Commission. Further, Movants state that they have conferred with the Public Staff and the Public Staff does not object to the requested extension.

The Chairman is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the requested extension of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the deadline for NCEMC to file its 2011 resource plan and for GreenCo to file its 2011 REPS compliance plan and 2010 REPS compliance report be, and is hereby, extended to September 19, 2011.
