Thank you for your submission of March 31, 2023, concerning the above-referenced project. We have reviewed the information provided and offer the following comments.

We concur with the proposed avoidance plan for sites 31HX699 and 31HX750, which includes incorporating a 30-foot buffer around each site and noting their locations on construction plans. We request that the excluded areas be noted on construction plans as "Environmentally Sensitive Areas" instead of "Cultural sites" and that temporary construction fencing be placed around the buffer boundaries during earth disturbing activities.

The above comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's Regulations for Compliance with Section 106 codified at 36 CFR Part 800.
