Thank you for your submission concerning the above referenced project. We have reviewed the information provided and offer the following comments.

Two cemeteries are located on the subject property, which have been designated 31HF295 and 31HF296. Cemeteries are protected by North Carolina General Statute Chapter 65. According to the submitted Cemetery Protection Protocol, a 120' buffer area around each cemetery will be delineated with high visibility fencing during photovoltaic generator installation. These temporary fences will be replaced with gated chain-link fences, and the cemeteries maintained through periodic mowing. These measures should be sufficient to avoid impacts to cemeteries 31HF295 and 31HF296 and ensure they remain accessible to interested parties.

The above comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's Regulations for Compliance with Section 106 codified at 36 CFR Part 800.
