#### **PUBLIC NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the North Carolina Utilities Commission has scheduled a public hearing on Tuesday, October 25, 2016, at 7:00p.m., at the Rockingham County Courthouse, Superior Courtroom A, 170 Highway 65, Reidsville, North Carolina.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive public witness testimony regarding the application of NTE Carolinas II, LLC (NTE) for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to construct a 500-MW natural-gas fueled merchant electric generating facility in Rockingham County, North Carolina. Public witness testimony will be received in accordance with Commission Rule R1-21 (g).

In summary, NTE states that it intends to construct a 500-MW combined cyclecombustion turbine electric generating facility to be fueled by natural gas. Construction is anticipated to begin in the first quarter of 2018. The location of the proposed facility is an approximately 170 acre tract located at 4781 NC Highway 65, bounded on the west by New Lebanon Church Road, with the facility being located on the west side of NC Highway 65, and a small portion of the site on the east side of NC Highway 65, near Reidsville, Rockingham County, North Carolina.

The facility will interconnect with the electric transmission grid operated by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC) via the Ernest Switching Station immediately adjacent to the facility site. All interconnection equipment will be located on the facility site, except a portion of the line connecting the facility to the Ernest Switching Station, which portion will be on DEC's property. NTE is in discussions with Piedmont Natural Gas

Company, Inc., to provide services as the natural gas distribution company for the facility. The expected service life of the facility is 30 years.

Specific information about NTE's application for a CPCN may be obtained from the Office of the Chief Clerk, North Carolina Utilities Commission, Raleigh, North Carolina, where a copy of NTE's application, exhibits and supporting testimony are available for review by the public, and on the Commission's website at www.neue.net.

The Public Staff is authorized by statute to represent consumers in proceedings before the Commission. Written statements to the Public Staff should include any information that the writers wish to be considered by the Public Staff in its investigation of the matter. Such statements should be addressed to Mr. Christopher J. Ayers, Executive Director, Public Staff, 4326 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, North Carolina 27699-4300.

The Attorney General is also authorized by statute to represent consumers in proceedings before the Commission. Statements to the Attorney General should be addressed to The Honorable Roy Cooper, Attorney General, 9001 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, North Carolina, 27699-9001.

Written statements are not evidence unless persons appear at a public hearing and testify concerning the information contained in their written statements.

Any person desiring to intervene in the proceeding as a formal party of record should file a petition under North Carolina Utilities Commission Rules R1-5 and R1-19 on or before Tuesday, October 18, 2016. Such petitions should be filed with the Chief Clerk of the North Carolina Utilities Commission, 4325 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, North Carolina 27699-4300. The direct testimony and exhibits of expert witnesses to be presented by intervenors should also be filed with the Commission on or before Tuesday, October 18, 2016.
