

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the
North Carolina Utilities Commission
has scheduled a public hearing on
Tuesday, October 25, 2016, at
7:00p.m., at the Rockingham
County Courthouse, Superior Court-
room A, 170 Highway 65, Reidsville,
North Carolina.

The purpose of the hearing is to re-
ceive public witness testimony re-
garding the application of NTE Caro-
linas II, LLC (NTE) for a certificate of
public convenience and necessity
(CPCN) to construct a 500-MW
natural-gas fueled merchant electric
generating facility in Rockingham
County, North Carolina. Public wit-
ness testimony will be received in
accordance with Commission Rule
R1-21 (g).

In summary, NTE states that it in-
tends to construct a 500-MW com-
bined cycle combustion turbine elec-
tric generating facility to be fueled
by natural gas. Construction is an-
ticipated to begin in the first quarter
of 2018. The location of the proposed
facility is an approximately 170 acre
tract located at 4781 NC Highway
65, bounded on the west by New
Lebanon Church Road, with the fa-
cility being located on the west side
of NC Highway 65, and a small por-
tion of the site on the east side of NC
Highway 65, near Reidsville, Rock-
ingham County, North Carolina.

The facility will interconnect with
the electric transmission grid oper-
ated by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC
(DEC) via the Ernest Switching Sta-
tion immediately adjacent to the fa-
cility site. All interconnection equip-
ment will be located on the facility
site, except a portion of the line con-
necting the facility to the Ernest
Switching Station, which portion will
be on DEC's property. NTE is in dis-
cussions with Piedmont Natural Gas

Company, Inc., to provide services
as the natural gas distribution com-
pany for the facility. The expected
service life of the facility is 30 years.

Specific information about NTE's ap-
plication for a CPCN may be ob-
tained from the Office of the Chief
Clerk, North Carolina Utilities Com-
mission, Raleigh, North Carolina,
where a copy of NTE's application,
exhibits and supporting testimony
are available for review by the pub-
lic, and on the Commission's website
at www.neue.net.
