BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On January 12, 2018, the Commission issued in the above-captioned proceeding an Order granting, subject to certain conditions, a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Convenience and Necessity to Duke Energy Progress, LLC for the construction of approximately 11.5 miles of new 230-kilovolt transmission line in Johnston and Wake Counties, North Carolina.

On February 7, 2018, Oliver L. Canaday, an intervening party to this proceeding, filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File an Appeal, pursuant to G.S. 62-90(a), requesting that the Commission extend the time, within which to file notice of appeal and exceptions to the Commission's January 12, 2018 Order, from February 12, 2018, to March 14, 2018. Mr. Canaday, a *pro se* party, states that the request is made in good faith and not for the purpose of delay.

Based upon the entire record in this proceeding and Mr. Canaday's Motion for Extension of Time to File an Appeal, the Presiding Commissioner is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the requested extension of time for all parties to this proceeding to file notice of appeal and exceptions to the Commission's January 12, 2018 Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that all parties to this proceeding shall be, and the same are hereby, granted an extension of time until March 14, 2018, within which to file a notice of appeal and exceptions to the Commission's January 12, 2018 Order.
