**JOINT MOTION OF DUKE
ENERGY PROGRESS, LLC AND
DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS,
LLC FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE PROPOSED ORDERS**

NOW COME Duke Energy Progress, LLC and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively “the Companies”) by and through counsel and pursuant to Rules R1-7 and R1-9 of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina Utilities Commission (“Commission”), and respectfully request that the Commission enter an order granting a thirty-one (31) day extension of time until May 17, 2021 for the Companies and Cube

Yadkin Generation, LLC (“Complainant”) to file briefs and proposed orders in this proceeding.

The Companies show the Commission the following:

1. On May 28, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Scheduling Hearing and Establishing Procedural Schedule on Remand*, which established new deadlines for discovery, prefiled testimony, and a hearing in this proceeding.

2. On September 1, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Granting Extension to Time to File Testimony* in this proceeding rescheduling the expert witness hearing in this proceeding to begin on January 26, 2021 and establishing deadlines for parties to file direct and rebuttal testimony.

3. On November 12, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Granting Second Extension of Time and Continuing Hearing*, which further extended the deadlines for discovery, prefiled testimony, and ordered that the hearing would be rescheduled by further order of the Commission.

4. On December 10, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Granting Third Extension of Time and Scheduling Remote Hearing*, which further extended the deadlines for prefiled testimony, and ordered that the hearing be held remotely on March 3, 2021, with specific deadlines to file lists of exhibits and consents to remote hearing.

5. On March 3, the Commission held an evidentiary hearing remotely via Webex, and on March 17, 2021, the Commission issued a notice of due dates for briefs and proposed orders to be filed on or before April 16, 2021.


6. The Companies are in the process of preparing their joint proposed order; however, due to the press of other business, they will be unable to file the proposed order

within the deadline set in the notice. Accordingly, the Companies respectfully request thirty-one (31) additional days, until May 17, 2021, for all parties to file briefs and proposed orders.

7. Counsel for Complainant has authorized the Companies to state that Complainant does not oppose the requested extension so long as it applies to both the Complainant and the Companies.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission grant an extension until May 17, 2021 for all parties to file briefs and proposed orders in this proceeding and any such further relief as the Commission deems just and proper.


