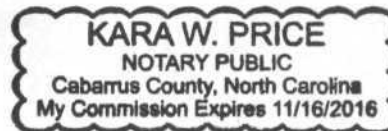

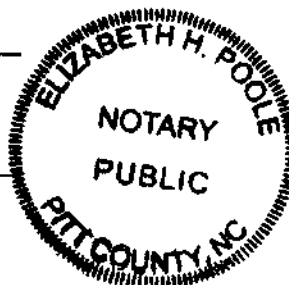

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 28, 2014, SolincPowers, LLC (Applicant), filed an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 5-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located on adjacent parcels of land at 662 W. Battleboro Ave. in Battleboro, Nash County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Dominion North Carolina Power.

If no complaint is received within the time specified above and if the Commission does not order a hearing upon its own initiative, the Commission will enter an order awarding the certificate sought by the Applicant.
