NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, the "Companies") and, pursuant to Rule R1-7 of the North Carolina Utilities Commission's (the "Commission") Rules and Regulations, respectfully move for a sevenday extension of time to file the Quarterly Report of the Low Income Affordability Collaborative (the "Collaborative Quarterly Report") in the above-captioned dockets. In support of this motion, the Companies show the following:

- 1. The Commission in its April 16, 2021 *Order Accepting Stipulations, Granting Partial Rate Increase and Requiring Customer Notice* in Docket Nos. E-2, Sub 1219 and Sub 1193 and its March 31, 2021 *Order Accepting Stipulations, Granting Partial Rate Increase, and Requiring Customer Notice* in Docket Nos. E-7, Sub 1213, Sub 1215, and Sub 1187 ("Rate Case Orders") established the Low Income Affordability Collaborative and required that the Companies and Public Staff jointly file Quarterly Reports summarizing progress of the Collaborative. Since April 15, 2022 falls on a holiday, the report would be due April 18, 2022.
- 2. The Companies have been working diligently to prepare the Quarterly Report but need additional time to complete the report. Accordingly, the Companies move the Commission for a seven (7) day extension of time, until and including April 25, 2022, to file the Quarterly Report.
- 3. Counsel for the Public Staff has indicated that they do not object to this motion.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order extending the time to file the Quarterly Report of the Collaborative to April 25, 2022, and such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
