BY THE CHAIR: On May 19, 2021, Currituck Water and Sewer, LLC (Currituck), and Sandler Utilities at Mill Run, LLC (Sandler), filed with the Commission an Application for Transfer of Public Utility Franchise and for Approval of Rates (Application) seeking authority to transfer the wastewater utility system and public utility franchise serving Eagle Creek Subdivision, Eagle Creek Golf Club and Grill, and Moyock Middle School in Currituck County, North Carolina, from Sandler to Currituck and approval of rates.

On November 18, 2021, the Commission issued an order requiring, among other things, that Currituck and Sandler are required to file separately, verified reports addressing all customer service and service quality complaints expressed during the public witness hearing held on February 2, 2022, within 15 days of the conclusion of the public witness hearing. The order requires the Public Staff and allows intervenors to file a verified response and any comments to Currituck and Sandler's reports on or before February 24, 2022.

The Commission held a public witness hearing on February 2, 2022. On February 15, 2022, the transcripts of the hearing and Official Exhibits Volume 1 were filed in the docket and made publicly available. The Official Exhibits Volume 2 were filed in the docket and made publicly available on February 17, 2022.

On February 16, 2022, Currituck filed a motion for an extension of time to file its customer service report. It states that it needs an additional 15 days to review the transcripts that were filed on February 15, 2022. Currituck requests an extension of time to and including March 2, 2022, to file its report in compliance with the Commission's Scheduling Order issued November 18, 2021. Currituck states that Sandler Utilities concurs and supports this request for extension of time. The Public Staff takes no position on this motion, however

the Public Staff would respectfully request that, if the Commission extends the public hearing report filing deadline, the Public Staff's verified responses should be due no earlier than seven days after the new, extended filing deadline for the report.

Based on the foregoing and the entire record herein, the Chair finds good cause to extend the deadline for Currituck and Sandler to file their reports to and including March 4, 2022. The Public Staff shall, and other intervenors may file a verified response and any comments to Currituck's and Sandler's reports on or before March 11, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
