Thank you so much for the time you have offered in dealing with the solar panel issue near the Terra Ceia area of Beaufort County, NC. Your help and willingness to work with us means so much to the community, parents, and students of this school. I am a parent of a fourth generation student at Terra Ceia Christian School and I have several extended family members that teach here.

Unfortunately, it seems we have come to yet another snag in the in crossroads of this saga where we have been given misinformation. I am writing to ask that you please pay close attention to the proposed changes made on the map and the expansion plan of the solar panel locations. What I have .. seen is completely different than what Wilkinson Solar produced earlier this year as a compromise with the community and Terra Ceia Christian School.

Please have another public hearing to consider these proposed changes. There are several reasons to hold a meeting:

- Environmental impacts of new plan
- Peat Fire in organic soil
- Loss of feeding grounds for migratory birds
- Economic Loss to the Local Christian School and Homeowners

It is my opinion that Wilkinson Solar, and their parent company, Invenergy, have worked quite *diligently* to either hide or omit facts in this matter. Most recently, their plan to change the location of the solar panels has now changed drastically, and is not congruent with what they led the school to believe earlier this year.
