On September 8th, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearing, Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Discovery Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice. That Order scheduled this hearing for today, November 1st, at 9:31 a.m.

On September 29th, 2023, Toccoa filed a Motion for Partial Suspension of Hearing Schedule.

On October 5th, 2023, the Commission granted Toccoa's Motion and continued the expert witness portion of the November 1st, 2023, hearing pending further Order of the Commission.
