BY THE CHAIRMAN: On July 14, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling a Show Cause Hearing, which, among other things, required that the direct testimony of Frontier Natural Gas Company (Frontier) and other intervenors be filed by September 25, 2017.

On September 25, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Granting Extension of Time to File Testimony, allowing Frontier until October 2, 2017 to file its direct testimony.

On September 28, 2017, Frontier filed a motion for extension of time, requesting that the Commission allow Frontier until October 4, 2017 to file its direct testimony. In support of its motion, Frontier states that it has been working to prepare its pre-filed testimony in this docket, but it will need an additional two days to complete this work and file its testimony with the Commission. Frontier further states that it conferred with the Commission Staff acting as a party to this proceeding, and that the Commission Staff consented to the requested extension.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record herein, the Chairman finds good cause to grant Frontier's requested additional extension of time in which to file its direct testimony from October 2, 2017 to October 4, 2017.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
