BY THE CHAIR: On August 30, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Granting Further Extension of Time to File Reply Comments in response to a motion by the Public Staff filed in the above-captioned dockets. The Order granted all parties an extension to October 7, 2019, to file reply comments regarding the demand-side management and energy efficiency (DSM/EE) mechanisms by which Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively, Duke) recover their DSM/EE costs and incentives.

On October 3, 2019, Duke filed a motion requesting that the date for reply comments be further extended to December 6, 2019. In summary, Duke stated that the parties continue to discuss points on which there may be consensus, and potential avenues for resolution of issues, and that a third meeting of the parties is scheduled for October 9, 2019. In addition, Duke listed a number of parties that it contacted about its proposed extension of time to file reply comments, being those parties who filed initial comments, and stated that they all consent to the proposed further extension of time.

Based on Duke's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to December 6, 2019, the date for parties to file reply comments on Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
