



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NOW COMES Duke Energy Progress, LLC (“DEP”) and, pursuant to Rule R1-7 of the North Carolina Utilities Commission (the “Commission”), respectfully moves the Commission for a one-week extension of time, until November 19, 2019, to file its progress report (“Progress Report”) in the above-captioned docket. In support of this motion, DEP shows the following:

1. On May 10, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity with Conditions* (the “Order”). Ordering paragraph 2 of the Order required that DEP file a progress report and revisions in cost estimates for the Hot Springs Microgrid Project no later than six months from the date of issuance of the Order. The Progress Report would have been due November 12, 2019, the first business day after November 10, 2019.
2. Due to the press of other business, DEP seeks a one-week extension of time to file its Progress Report.
3. Counsel for the Public Staff has indicated that they do not object to this motion.

WHEREFORE, DEP respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order extending the time to file its Progress Report by one week, from November 12, 2019 through and including November 19, 2019, and such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
