BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On July 26, 2022, Carolina Water Service, Inc. of North Carolina (CWSNC or Applicant), filed with the Commission an application in Docket No. W-354, Sub 398 for Determination of Fair Value of Utility Assets in Carteret County, in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.1A (the Application).

On August 5, 2022, pursuant to Commission Rule R7-41 and N.C.G.S. § 62-133.1A, the Public Staff filed its correspondence to the Applicant outlining the deficiencies in the Application (Deficiency Letter).

The Applicant has informed the Commission that it agrees, at least in part, with the Deficiency Letter and that it is appropriate to supplement the Application.

Accordingly, pursuant to Rule R7-41(e), the Commission determines that the Application is incomplete as submitted. Accordingly, the Application is not yet deemed to be filed for the purposes of calculating the date upon which a final order is due to be issued pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-133.1A(d).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1 That the Applicant shall file the omitted information;
- 2 That the Applicant shall consult with the Public Staff to ensure the completeness of the Application; and

3 That once the Applicant has filed the material supplementing the Application, the Public Staff shall, no later than three business days following such filing, file a statement as to whether it deems the Application to be complete.
