BY THE CHAIR: On June 11, 2020, in the above-captioned proceeding, the Commission issued its Order Denying Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Merchant Generating Facility.

On June 24, 2020, Friesian Holdings, LLC and the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association (Movants), each parties to this proceeding, filed a Joint Motion for an Extension of Time to File Notice of Appeal and Exceptions pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-90(a) seeking an additional 30 days within which to appeal the Commission's June 11, 2020 Order. Movants explain that they have diligently worked through the Order but anticipate needing additional time to adequately assess whether to file a Notice of Appeal and Exceptions. Movants also explain that the COVID-19 pandemic has complicated and made irregular the normal methods to review the substantive issues contained within the Order. Movants further represent that they contacted all other parties and that no party objected to the motion.

The Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that all parties shall have an additional 30 days pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-90(a) or until August 10, 2020, within which to file Notice of Appeal and Exceptions in this proceeding.
