Thank you for your submission concerning the above referenced project. We have reviewed the materials provided and offer the following comments.

Two cemeteries, 31HF295 and 31HF296, are located on the subject property. Cemeteries are protected by North Carolina General Statute Chapter 65. In order to determine that the proposed project will not impact cemeteries 31HF295 and 31HF296, we request project designs showing that the cemeteries will be avoided, and a description of measures that will be taken to ensure these areas will not be subject to ground disturbance during construction. Alternatively, if cemeteries 31HF295 and 31HF296 are relocated, we request documentation of this process.

We have reviewed your amended submittal, and determined that a portion of the proposed project expansion (Gordon parcel) is directly adjacent to the National Register-listed William Mitchel House (HF0005). The historic property is eligible for listing under Criterion C for architecture. Due to a lack of continued association with agriculture, the property is not eligible under Criterion A. Even though the project proposes to develop the surrounding land within view of the William Mitchell House, there will be no adverse effect to the property.

The above comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's Regulations for Compliance with Section 106 codified at 36 CFR Part 800.
