On June 24, 2020, WCU filed an amendment to its application, which is on file with the Commission. WCU operates an off-campus electric distribution system that serves approximately 3,170 residential customers and 230 commercial customers.

In its application, WCU requests authority to increase its rates to produce additional overall annual retail revenues of approximately \$625,500, an increase of approximately 13.7% over current revenues. WCU states that, since its last general rate case in 2015, it has made plant investments and sustained higher operating costs in its electric distribution and sustained by law to

The Commission may consider additional or alternative rate design proposals that were not included in the original application and may order increases or decreases in the schedules that differ from those proposed by WCU. However, any rate structure considered will not generate more overall revenues than requested.

The average monthly residential bill for 1,000 kWh usage would increase fran \$109.92 to \$124.39 (13.2%) after adjusting for purchased power charges.
