We have received the archaeological survey report for the above project from Dr. Susan Bamann of Coastal Carolina Research (CCR).

During the course of the survey, four sites were located within the project area.

The following properties are determined not eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places: 31HX434\*\*, 31HX435\*\*, 31HX436\*\* and 31HX437\*\*; lack of integrity and inability to contribute to the understanding of the area's history

Dr. Bamann has recommended that no further archaeological investigation be conducted in connection with this project. We concur with this recommendation since the project will not involve significant archaeological resources.
