BY THE CHAIRMAN: On February 9, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Requiring Verification of 2010 REPS Compliance Reports and Requesting Comments in the above-captioned dockets. The Order requested that the Public Staff and other parties file comments by April 5, 2012, on the 2010 Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard (REPS) Compliance Reports filed by Energy United, Public Works Commission of Fayetteville, City of Fountain, GreenCo Solutions, Inc., Halifax Electric Membership Corporation, North Carolina Eastern Municipal Power Agency, North Carolina Municipal Power Agency No. 1, Town of Oak City, Tennessee Valley Authority and Town of Winterville.

On April 3, 2012, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time requesting that all parties have until April 27, 2012 to file their comments. The Motion states, among other things, that the Public Staff has worked diligently to prepare its comments but issues have arisen that necessitated sending a data request to the Public Works Commission of Fayetteville, and Fayetteville has not yet responded to the data request.

The Chairman is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the requested extension of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the deadline for the Public Staff and all parties to file comments in this docket is extended to April 27, 2012.
