BY THE CHAIR: On March 14, 2024, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct an 850 MW Natural Gas-Fired Combustion Turbine Electric Generating Facility in Catawba County, North Carolina. On April 10, 2024, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearings, Establishing Procedural and Filing Requirements, and Requiring Public Notice (Scheduling Order), which among other things, allowed petitions to intervene to be filed on or before June 6, 2024, directed the Public Staff and other intervenors to file direct testimony and exhibits on or before June 6, 2024, and directed DEC to file rebuttal testimony on or before July 2, 2024.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the public notice attached to the Scheduling Order incorrectly identified the date for the filing of petitions to intervene and the direct testimony of intervenors as June 20, 2024. Based on the record as a whole, the Chair finds good cause to extend the dates for the filing of petitions to intervene, the direct testimony of intervenors, and the rebuttal testimony of DEC. Petitions to intervene may be filed on or before June 20, 2024, the Public Staff and other intervenors may file direct testimony and exhibits on or before June 20, 2024, and DEC may file rebuttal testimony on or before July 16, 2024.

The Commission notes that the dates related to discovery provided in its May 15, 2024 Order Amending Procedural Schedule To Allow Additional Time For Discovery are no longer applicable. The Commission directs DEC to consult with the intervenors to this docket, and, to file a motion with the Commission requesting modifications if additional amendments to the discovery deadlines are required due to the dates provided in this order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
