

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on August 14, 2013, SunEnergy 1, LLC (Applicant), filed an application, as amended on December 5, 2014, seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 12-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located on the north side of Watson Seed Farm Road at the intersection with Bellamy Mill Road in Whitakers, Nash County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Dominion North Carolina Power.

If no complaint is received within the time specified above and if the Commission does not order a hearing upon its own initiative, the Commission will enter an order awarding the certificate sought by the Applicant.
