BY THE CHAIRMAN: On September 17, 2013, in Docket No. SP-2665, Sub 1, the Commission issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), to Fresh Air Energy II, LLC (FAE II), for construction of a 5-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 119 Thornton Lane in Snow Hill, Greene County, North Carolina. In addition, the Commission accepted the registration of the facility as a new renewable energy facility.

On August 5, 2014, FAE II and Fresh Air Energy XVI, LLC (FAE XVI), filed a statement with the Commission in Docket Nos. SP- 2665, Sub 1 and SP-3760, Sub 0 requesting that the Commission transfer the CPCN and registration for the facility from FAE II to FAE XVI.

Based on the foregoing and the record in these dockets, the Chairman finds good cause to transfer the CPCN and registration for the facility from FAE II to FAE XVI, cancel the CPCN issued to FAE II, issue a new CPCN to FAE XVI and close Docket No. SP-2665, Sub 1.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the application filed by Fresh Air Energy II, LLC, and Fresh Air Energy XVI, LLC, to transfer the certificate of public convenience and necessity for construction of a 5-MW photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 119 Thornton Lane in Snow Hill, Greene County, North Carolina, and registration to Fresh Air Energy XVI, LLC shall be, and is hereby, approved.

2. That Appendix A shall constitute the amended certificate of public convenience and necessity reflecting the transfer of the certificate to Fresh Air Energy XVI, LLC.

3. That Fresh Air Energy XVI, LLC, shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year.

4. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Fresh Air Energy II, LLC, in Docket No. SP-2665, Sub 1 for this solar photovoltaic facility shall be, and is hereby, cancelled.

5. That the Chief Clerk shall close Docket No. SP-2665, Sub 1.
