On August 11, 2020, Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC), filed applications for adjustments to the annual cost recovery riders in the following proceedings:

- Docket No. E-22, Sub 588 – Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard (REPS)
- Docket No. E-22, Sub 589 – Demand-Side Management and Energy Efficiency (DSM/EE)
- Docket No. E-22, Sub 590 – Fuel and Fuel-Related Adjustments
