) ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF
) 50/50 HYBRID PILOT

BY THE COMMISSION: By letter dated October 20, 2017, NC GreenPower (NCGP) requests that the Commission grant an additional extension of its approved 50/50 Hybrid Pilot. In support of its request, NCGP states that at the July 13, 2017 Board of Directors meeting, staff recommended and the Board approved extending the program to collect more data due to potential external market changes. NCGP asserts that the recommended 4th year would conclude at the end of 2018 and a final summary report would be provided to the North Carolina Utilities Commission (NCUC) by December 31, 2018. NCGP acknowledges that a summary report on Pilot Year 3 of the 50/50 Hybrid Program is expected to be submitted by the end of December 2017.

In a letter filed in this docket, dated October 23, 2017, the Public Staff indicates that it has no objection and recommends that the Commission extend the term of the 50/50 Hybrid Pilot to December 31, 2018, and require submission of a summary report by the end of year three and of a final summary report within 30 days of the end of the pilot.

The Commission finds good cause to grant the extension of the 50/50 Hybrid Pilot as it will benefit NCGP and the Commission in assessment of the effectiveness of the pilot.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, as follows:

1. That the NCGP 50/50 Hybrid Pilot is extended from December 31, 2017, to December 31, 2018; and


2. That NCGP shall submit a summary report by the end of year three and a final summary report to the Commission within 30 days of the end of year four of the pilot.
