NOW COMES Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP" or "Petitioner"), pursuant to North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") Rules R1-5 and R1-19, by and through the undersigned counsel, and petitions the Commission to enter an order permitting DEP to intervene and fully participate in the above-referenced docket. In support of this Petition, DEP shows the following:

- 1. DEP is an electric utility organized, existing and operating under the laws of the State of North Carolina for the purposes of generating, transmitting, and distributing electric power in its assigned service territory in North and South Carolina. Its principal office is located at 410 S. Wilmington Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27601.

- 3. On December 9, 2020, Sunstone Energy Development LLC ("Sunstone") filed a corrected request for declaratory ruling ("Petition") that (1) Fort Bragg is not subject to the North Carolina Public Utilities Act ("Public Utilities Act") because it is a federal enclave; (2) Sunstone's provision of solar energy and energy efficiency services within the federal enclave of Fort Bragg does not subject it or its assignees, nor their work, to the Public Utilities Act; and (3) Sunstone's proposed activities will not cause it to be considered a public utility under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-3(23).
- 4. Fort Bragg is a customer of DEP's, and thus Sunstone's Petition implicates DEP's service rights pursuant to the Public Utilities Act.
- 5. DEP has a real and substantial interest in this proceeding. The Commission's determination as to Sunstone's Petition not only directly impacts DEP, but the general subject matter of this docket also affects DEP and its retail customers. DEP's interests cannot be adequately represented by any other party.
- 6. Pursuant to Commission Rule R1-39, DEP agrees to accept electronic service of all filings in the docket.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, DEP petitions the Commission to enter an order granting the right to intervene in this matter and exercise all rights provided to intervenors under the Commission's Rules and North Carolina law.
