BY THE CHAIRMAN: On August 19, 2015, in the above-captioned proceeding, the Commission issued an Order accepting the application for registration as a new renewable energy facility filed by Cork Oak Solar, LLC (Applicant), pursuant to Commission Rule R8-66, for its 20-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located in Halifax County, North Carolina.

On November 20, 2017, Applicant filed a letter requesting that the Commission cancel the registration of its facility as a new renewable energy facility.


