following initial comments.

In its November 6 Order, the Commission expressed an interest in the viability of a tiered incentive system under which the incentive amount would decline as the system size approached the maximum. The Commission stated that this structure could benefit customers with greater budget constraints, who might be installing smaller systems, and would recognize that the cost per watt decreases as system size increases.

SACE shares the Commission's interest in ensuring that the rebate system serves the broadest set of customers possible by making access to clean energy more affordable. SACE also is interested in exploring whether a tiered system would serve this goal, among other options. However, SACE does not have sufficient information at this point to determine whether it would be the best solution to pursue.

SACE looks forward to reviewing the information that the Commission has required Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC to submit in their initial comments, as well as the initial comments of other parties, and anticipates filing reply comments.
