On November 1, 2017, in Docket Nos. W-1300, Sub 47 and W-661. Sub 9, Old North State Water Company, LLC (Old North State) and Fitch Creations, Inc., d/b/a Fearrington Utilities (Fitch), filed an application to transfer the certificate of public convenience and necessity for sewer utility service in Fearrington Village in Chatham County, North Carolina from Fitch to Old North State and for approval of rates. On November 16, 2017, an addendum to the application was filed and on May 9, 2018, a consumer statement of position was filed in these two dockets. No further activity has occurred in Docket No. W-1300, Sub 47 since May 9, 2018.

Subsequently, on August 5, 2019, in Docket Nos. W-1320, Sub 2 and W-661, Sub 9, Old North State filed a letter with the Commission from its President, Michael Myers, stating that since the filing in 2017 of the transfer application in Docket Nos. W-1300, Sub 47 and W-661, Sub 9, Old North State's parent company, Integra Water, had formed ONSWC Chatham North, LLC (Chatham North), with the intention of transferring the wastewater assets acquired from Fitch into Chatham North rather than Old North State.

Also on August 5, 2019, in Docket Nos. W-1320, Sub 2 and W-661, Sub 9, Chatham North and Fitch filed an application to transfer the certificate of public convenience and necessity for sewer utility service in Fearrington Village in Chatham County, North Carolina from Fitch to Chatham North and for approval of rates. Such filing also included an amended purchase agreement.

Thereafter, the Chief Clerk copied the consumer statement of position filed on May 8, 2018, in Docket No. W-1300, Sub 47 to Docket No. W-1320, Sub 2.

Chatham North's filings on August 5, 2019, in Docket No. W-1320, Sub 2 supersede Old North State's filings on November 1, 2017 and November 16, 2017, in Docket No. W-1300, Sub 47. As a result, no further action is required by the Commission or Old North State in Docket No. W-1300, Sub 47.

Please close Docket No. W-1300, Sub 47.

Fearrington Utility and Old North State Water Company filed a joint application (W-661 Sub 9 and W-1300 Sub 47) for the transfer of Fearrington Utility to Old North State Water Company on November 1, 2017. Since that time, Integra Water has formed ONSWC Chatham North, LLC with the intention of transferring the Briar Chapel and Fearrington wastewater utilities into that company.

On March 14, 2019, Old North State Water Company and ONSWC Chatham North, LLC filed a joint application to transfer Briar Chapel to ONSWC Chatham North LLC (W-1300 Sub 55 and W-1320 Sub 2).

This application is being filed to transfer the pending application before the commission for the transfer of Fearrington Utility (W-661 Sub 9) from Old North State Water Company (W1300 Sub 47) to ONSWC Chatham North, LLC (W-1320 sub 2).
