BY THE CHAIR: On September 20, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments on the Public Staff's Petition to Amend Commission Rules R8-63 and R8-64. The Order provided that parties may file initial comments addressing the proposed changes to Commission Rules R8-63 and Rule R8-64 on or before October 19, 2021, and that all parties may file reply comments on or before November 16, 2021.

On October 12, 2021, Carolinas Clean Energy Business Association (CCEBA) filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Comments. In its Motion, CCEBA stated that its participation in a proceeding before the South Carolina Public Service Commission has taken substantial time and requests a two-week extension for all parties to file initial comments. CCEBA further stated in its motion that the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association and the Public Staff have consented to the requested extension.

Based on CCEBA's motion and the record as a whole, the Chair finds good cause to grant the requestion extension. Parties may file initial comments addressing the proposed changes to Commission Rules R8-63 and Rule R8-64 on or before November 2, 2021, and all parties may file reply comments on or before November 30, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That on or before November 2, 2021, persons having an interest in this matter may file petitions to intervene in this docket;
2. That on or before November 2, 2021, all parties may file initial comments addressing the proposed changes to Commission Rules R8-63 and Rule R8-64 as filed by the Public Staff on August 19, 2021; and

3. That all parties may file reply comments on or before November 30, 2021.
