In accordance with the North Carolina Utility Commission's ("the Commission") September 4, 2008 Order in the Docket E-100, Sub 121, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association ("NCSEA") hereby respectfully submits the following comments on establishing a process for defining renewable energy certificate ("REC") tracking system requirements. NCSEA is a Section 501(c)(3) non-profit association that provides public education, collaborative leadership, and policy and technical analyses to ensure a sustainable future by promoting renewable energy and energy efficiency. NCSEA supports policies that advance a viable market and regulatory environment which enables citizens, businesses and government to use and benefit from economically and environmentally sustainable energy solutions. BACKGROUND

In a prior filing, NCSEA proffered the elements and criteria necessary to provide a functional and cost-effective tracking system to assure compliance with North Carolina's Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard ("REPS"). The adoption of these criteria and elements is necessary to evaluate qualified tracking systems, consistent with national trends, and assure that North Carolina's REPS is in line with recognized best practices to meet the goals and the objectives envisioned by the General Assembly when the standard was adopted as law and implemented by the Commission's rules.

NCSEA thanks the Commission for opening a docket and convening stakeholder groups to evaluate and identify the requisite elements and criteria for appropriate REC Tracking System requirements.

COMMENTS

NCSEA has a broad range of substantive knowledge on REC tracking system functionality and requirements for administratively simplifying REPS compliance. However, estimating numbers of users the system needs to accommodate is best answered in the work group process. As with many issues that are unique to North Carolina rules, such as combining REC tracking for renewable energy and verified energy efficiency savings, and including British Thermal Unit ("Btu") equivalents, the stakeholder process should be allowed to detail the specific functionalities.

Thus, we propose dual working groups, one of which is to specify interfaces to upload data from the varieties of renewable energy and energy efficiency resources set

forth by the rules and one for functionalities associated with transferring RECs between accounts, retiring RECs for compliance, and producing reports.
