3 A. Per my Schedule 6, customers served on a residential rate will see a total
4 REPS charge on their bill of \$0.16 which is a decrease of \$0.09 per month
5 from the previous monthly REPS charge. Commercial customers will see a
6 \$0.82 charge per month on their bills resulting in a decrease of \$0.55 per
7 month from the previous monthly REPS charge. An industrial customer will
8 see a charge of \$5.73 per month resulting in a decrease of \$3.39 per month
9 from the previous monthly REPS charge. Monthly billing schedules will be
10 prorated only if the number of days in the billing month is less than 26 or
11 greater than 40.

12 **Q. Does this conclude your pre-filed direct testimony?**

13 A. Yes, it does.

1 **Q. Would you explain how the proposed Riders RP and RPE will impact**
2 **customers' bills?**

3 A. Per my Schedule 6, customers served on a residential rate will see a total
4 REPS charge on their bill of ~~\$0.150.16~~ which is a decrease of ~~\$0.100.09~~ per
5 month from the previous monthly REPS charge. Commercial customers will
6 see a ~~\$0.800.82~~ charge per month on their bills resulting in a decrease of
7 ~~\$0.570.55~~ per month from the previous monthly REPS charge. An industrial
8 customer will see a charge of ~~\$5.575.73~~ per month resulting in a decrease of
9 ~~\$3.553.39~~ per month from the previous monthly REPS charge. Monthly
10 billing schedules will be prorated only if the number of days in the billing
11 month is less than 26 or greater than 40.

12 **Q. Does this conclude your pre-filed direct testimony?**

13 A. Yes, it does.
