That CWSNC shall submit a proposed customer notice to the Commission for review and approval, and upon approval of the notice by the Commission, shall give appropriate notice of the approved rate increase by mailing the notice to each of the System customers during the billing cycle following the closing of the sale of the System.

Notice is given that by Order dated August 29, 2023 (Order), the North Carolina Utilities Commission (Commission) approved the transfer of ownership of the Carteret County water system to Carolina Water Service, Inc. of North Carolina (CWSNC or Company) and granted CWSNC a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to provide water utility service in the North River/Mill Creek and Merrimon service areas effective upon the date CWSNC provides the Commission notice of closing of the sales transaction. CWSNC's ownership of the water system will begin when the purchase is closed by CWSNC and Carteret County.

Under the CPCN granted to CWSNC, the Company is authorized to charge the water rates attached to this Notice to Customers effective for service rendered on and after the date of closing of the transfer of the Carteret County water utility system assets to CWSNC. CWSNC has agreed that rates charged to the customers of the Carteret County water system will remain at Carteret County's current water rates for a period of four years from the date the sale of the System is closed, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
