BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On May 8, 2023, Shawboro East Ridge Solar, LLC (Shawboro or Applicant) filed a Motion for Order Requiring Submission of Proposed Orders in the above-referenced docket. Shawboro requests that the Commission issue an order concluding that no further evidentiary hearings or submissions are necessary and that the parties shall submit proposed orders regarding Shawboro's requested certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN).
