BY THE CHAIR: On January 10, 2022, the Commission issued an Order, in the above-captioned docket, directing all parties to file comments addressing Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC's and Duke Energy Progress, LLC's (collectively, Duke or the Companies) Joint Application for Approval of Revised Net Energy Metering Tariffs. Pursuant to the Order, interested parties were allowed to file initial comments and petitions to intervene on or before March 15, 2022, and reply comments on or before April 14, 2022.

On February 23, 2022, NC WARN and The Environmental Working Group (EWG) filed a joint motion requesting a 45-day extension of time on the deadlines for all parties to file initial comments, petitions to intervene, and reply. On March 3, 2022, the Commission issued an Order granting a 14-day extension of time, making initial comments due on March 29, 2022, and reply comments due on April 28, 2022.

On April 22, 2022, Duke, Sundance Power Systems, Inc., Southern Energy Management, Inc., and Yes Solar Solutions (collectively, North Carolina Rooftop Solar Installers) filed a joint motion requesting a 14-day extension of time for all parties to file reply comments. In support of the motion, Duke and the North Carolina Rooftop Solar Installers state that Duke has been working diligently on reply comments and held discussions with the North Carolina Rooftop Solar Installers regarding certain recommendations in their initial comments. According to the movants, allowing additional time will enable Duke and the North Carolina Rooftop Solar Installers to further engage in dialogue in an effort to reach a resolution on these issues. Duke and the North Carolina Rooftop Solar Installers further state that no party will be prejudiced by the requested extension.

Based on the joint motion and the record, the Chair hereby grants the motion to extend the date for filing reply comments to May 12, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
