BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On January 16, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Granting Extension of Time in the above-captioned docket. The Order requires parties to file their initial comments by March 14, 2014, and to file their reply comments by March 28, 2014.

On March 12, 2014, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy and the Sierra Club (Movants) filed a motion requesting that the dates for comments and reply comments be extended to April 11, 2014, and April 25, 2014, respectively. In support of their motion, Movants state that on March 7, 2014, Duke Energy Progress, Inc., and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively, Duke) filed supplements to their integrated resource plans (IRPs) correcting certain inputs to their production cost analyses. Movants further state that they have requested data from Duke about the IRP supplements, and that they need additional time to receive the data and use it in preparing their comments. In addition, Movants state that they have not received any objection from any party to their request for an extension of time.

Based on the record in this docket and the Movants' motion, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend the date for filing initial comments to April 11, 2014, and to extend the date for filing reply comments to April 25, 2014.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
