## Transportation Expense - Fuel

## AS UPDATED:

Transportation expense FUEL has been updated for the latest fuel prices for (a) Aqua North Carolina Water and Sewer (b) Brookwood Water and (c) Fairways Utilities Water and Sewer.

UPDATE - the Company has updated to the 9/19/22 average fuel price for the Lower Atlantic region on the eia.gov website. https://www.eia.gov/petroleum/gasdiesel/

The price as of $9 / 19 / 22$ is $\$ 3.298$ (vs. $\$ 4.566$ from the filing) per gallon and this has been applied to the test year volume of fuel purchased. The adjustment amount in the initial filing was $\$ 471,099.59$. With the updated price, the adjustment is now $\$ 143,766.25$, a reduction to this expense of $\$ 327,333.34$ from the initial filing amount.

The following schedules are attached to support the test year amount:

- Transportation Expense - Item 182022 Fuel Price Adjustment (Exhibit B3-p-2). This schedule summarizes Aqua NC's test year fuel volume and cost. The Company has now applied the September 19, 2022 average fuel price from the eia.gov website to the test year volume to calculate this adjustment. The difference between this newly calculated amount and the initial amount is the Item 18 adjustment amount.
