BY THE CHAIR: On December 31, 2019, Aqua North Carolina, Inc. (Aqua), filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust and increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its service areas in North Carolina.

On October 26, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Approving Partial Settlement Agreement and Stipulation, Deciding Contested Issues, Granting Partial Rate Increase, and Requiring Customer Notice which continued the semiannual reporting requirement regarding water quality issues.

On August 31, 2022, Aqua filed a request to extend the time to file the Seventeenth Semiannual Report Regarding Secondary Water Quality Concerns until Friday, September 30, 2022. In its request, Aqua states that the extension of time is required due to the press of issues and dockets currently pending before the Commission and the time required to collaborate with the Public Staff to prepare the joint report. Aqua notes that the Public Staff does not oppose the request.

Based on the foregoing, the Chair finds good cause to extend the time for Aqua to file the Seventeenth Semiannual Report Regarding Secondary Water Quality Concerns until Friday, September 30, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
